

CSBG Eligibility Guide

To be eligible for the CSBG-funded School Break Externship program, youth must:

- Have a household income at or below the Income Guidelines **or** live in one of the Special Housing Situations below **or** be a current or former foster youth.
 - Youth in families receiving Medical, CalWORKs, or CalFresh may demonstrate participation in any of those three programs instead of demonstrating household income.

Income Guidelines

Persons in Household	Monthly Income
1	\$1,005.00
2	\$1,353.33
3	\$1,701.66
4	\$2,050.00
5	\$2,398.33
6	\$2,746.66
7	\$3,095.00
8	\$3,443.33

For each additional household member, add \$348.33 per month.

Special Housing Situations

If any of the following statements are true of the participant, they do not need to qualify based on the monthly income guidelines.

- Their family is having financial troubles, so they lost their home.
- They are staying with a family besides their own due to financial troubles.
- They live in a motel, hotel, trailer park, or camping ground as a result of their family's inability to find other housing.
- They live in an emergency or transitional shelter.
- They regularly sleep in a park, vehicle, public space, bus or train station, or abandoned building.
